4.0 BUSINESS FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

- 4.1 Income statement review- Foundation (*attached*) P. Chatelain
 - Year end statement provided but it still has to be audited
 - 50/50 distribution is provided on the year end sheet
- 4.2 Income statement review SCM Redevelopment (attached) P. Chatelain
 - April proceeds shown
- 4.3 Monthly report (*attached*) A. Lougheed
 - Jackpot of the month of April was \$10,030.00
 - 50/50 advertisements continue to go out regularly
 - Attended Iroquois Falls Sportsmen show
 - Working with BRM to organize a Canada Day event where the foundation will be responsible for the bar and all profits from it
 - \$10K donation received for AGH portable ultrasound machine
 - \$20K donation received for equipment and mattresses at SCM
- 4.4 SCM Redevelopment Update P. Chatelain
 - Fundraising spreadsheet overview was approved by the ministry of longterm care
 - Met with James McBride to confirm we could get the \$20M term sheet (since we are taking \$7M upfront)
 - Should be shovel ready by November 30, 2024
- 4.5 SCM Redevelopment Fundraising Campaign G. Forget
 - Timeline to purchase the thermometer to show money raised for SCM Redevelopment
 - P. Chatelain recommends putting up the thermometer after we get a signed development agreement
 - 4.5.1 Iroquois Falls Sportsman Show G. Forget

- Well attended by the public and supported by a number of volunteers
- Raised \$575 for the SCM Redevelopment
- 4.5.2 Cochrane Delegation C. Goulet
 - Letter was written from a personal stand point to show Cochrane's want for the SCM Redevelopment
 - Mayor is not responsive
- 4.5.3 Grant applications A. Lougheed
 - Applications submitted to Agnico Eagle and Newmont
 - RBC application submitted

5.0 NEW BUSINESS

- 5.1 Villeneuve construction and Labelle Foundation S. de Laplante
 - Presentation made to the president of Villeneuve construction with a \$250,000 ask
 - Presentation and request sent to the Labelle Foundation for \$5M
- 5.2 Monthly 50/50 in person sales A. Lougheed
 - \$525.00 per machine and approximately \$20/month thereafter for SIM charge and \$35/month for Pay Safe Account
 - The device can be used with card or cash payments
- 5.3 Split the pot lottery A. Lougheed
 - Requires Ascend instead of BUMP
 - Recommending we wait for a new coordinator to ensure proper training on the platform if we decide to move ahead
- 5.4 BRM Canada Day Fundraiser A. Lougheed
 - Recommending that funds raised should go to BMH or Rosedale
 - Everything is in place for this event to proceed
- 5.5 SCM Open Forum P. Chatelain
 - Mitch the architect will be in attendance
 - A fundraising update will be provided
 - Finance update will be provided
 - Overall project update will be provided and a Q&A session to follow
- 5.6 Appraisal on existing manor P. Chatelain
 - Cost of \$8,240 + HST to have it appraised by Northern Appraisals

6.0 OTHER BUSINESS

- 6.1 NOHFC Intern Grant Update P. Chatelain
 - We are eligible to reapply and will submit an application shortly
- 6.2 Giftabulator P. Chatelain
 - Very expensive to onboard with this company upwards of \$50K
 - They have had success with other homes in the past such as Ivan Franko Homes in Mississauga
 - Will continue to look for other options
- 6.3 Reaching out to suppliers S. de Laplante
 - Recommending we reach out to our suppliers for funding for the Redevelopment
 - P. Chatelain and A. Lougheed have done this in the past with no success but will look into it again
