5.3 **SCM Redevelopment Update – P. Chatelain**

- A delegation with the Minister of Long-Term Care took place on August 19th.
- The Minister of Long-Term Care signed the Development Agreement (DA).
- The pre-qualification process for contractors has begun, with anticipated completion by September 25th.
- The next step is to initiate the tendering process in early October, aiming for completion by mid-November.
- A slight increase in construction costs is anticipated.
- The project is expected to be ready for construction by November 30th, 2024.

5.4 Buy a Brick Campaign Update – P. Chatelain

• The Buy a Brick Campaign has now raised \$20,700 since its launch.
